

A COUNTY TOWN'S UNIQUE SCOTTISH HERITAGE

Ceremonies are held in **The Adam Room** within Haddington's former Sheriff Court dating from 1833.

The building occupies the site of the medieval Royal Palace of Haddington that existed from the 12th to the 13th century. It was located on King Street (now Court Street) in Haddington, and was the birthplace of **King of Scots Alexander II** in 1198 who reigned from 1214 to 1249.

The palace was also an occasional residence of his father **William I** (The Lion).

Today the building forms part of East Lothian Council's headquarters, though echoes of its historic past can be seen, and sensed, all around.

French windows take you out to our landscaped Courtyard Gardens providing excellent opportunity for photography both indoor and outdoor.






Dunbar Town House Museum & Gallery High Street, Dunbar, EH42 1ER
